You will be able to prepare food for the elephants, bath and wash the elephants and contribute to the running of the sanctuary by volunteering.

The Asian elephant is an endangered species and holds a unique place in Thai culture and the Buddhist religion.

The park has been open for 20 years, has over 70 elephants and roughly 250 workers. It is surrounded by lush mountains and is divided down the middle by a river. This is a relaxing atmosphere, and a great place for volunteers who also

want to appreciate the Thai countryside. Volunteers assist and work alongside elephant trainers and other park staff from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm (Monday through Friday).

Our representatives will meet you at Chang Mai airport and take you to the Elephant Sanctuary where you will check in to your Thai Style Bamboo Hut. You will also have the opportunity to visit Chang Mai during your stay.
