We can smell and taste lemons, limes, real lemonade and lychee juice.

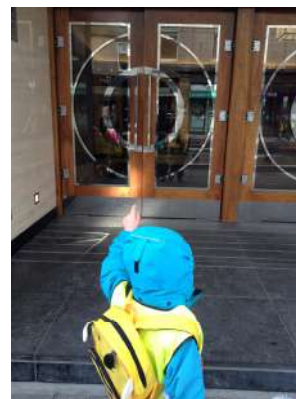


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## Numeracy - Symmetry
