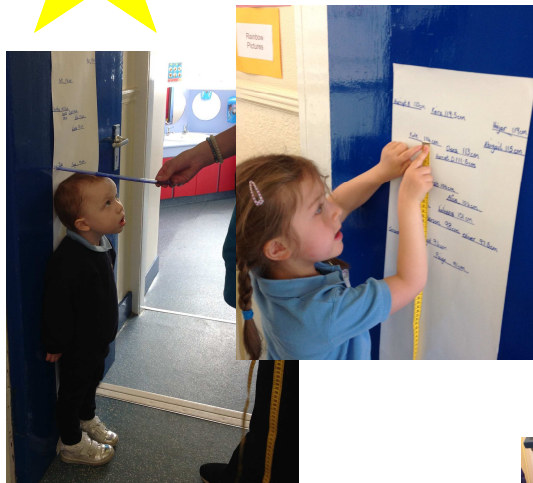




Numeracy - measure



This week all our children had their height measured and were able to use the measuring tape to compare their own height against others.

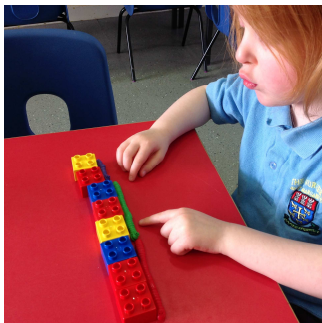
Using language relating to measure: bigger, smaller, longer, shorter whilst playing on the computer.

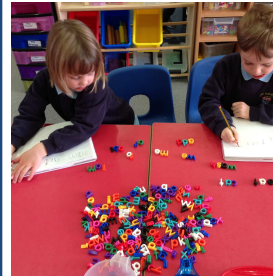
The letter 'w' and Grow Well Choices.
